Please consume alcoholic beverage responsibly and assign a designated driver.

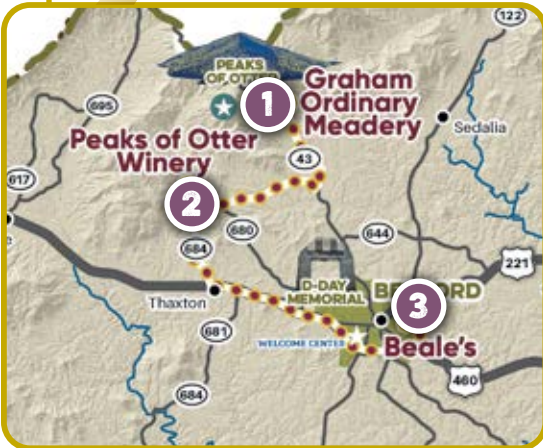

Start your beverage adventure in the northern part of the county, just off the famous *Blue Ridge Parkway*. On Route 43, a short drive from the *Peaks of Otter*, you'll find the **Graham Ordinary Meadery**. Sample the world's oldest fermented beverage.



Continue to the **Peaks of Otter Winery** and try some delicious fruit wines while enjoying beautiful views of the *Blue Ridge Mountains*. The winery is also an orchard and farm where guests can pick fruits in season, view the farm animals, enjoy the picnic areas and take a photo with a *LOVEworks* sign.

South of the *Town of Bedford* on the way to *Smith Mountain Lake*, **Fables & Feathers Winery** is a family- and pet-friendly destination where everyone will feel welcome. In addition to red, white and sweet wines, the talented team at **Fables & Feathers** also brews great craft beers and cider on site.

Ramulose Ridge Vineyard in Moneta offers a modern, yet relaxed countryside vineyard setting, just minutes from *Smith Mountain Lake*. Sample dry white and dry red wines, as well as a delicious house-made sangria.

Also in *Moneta*, **Hickory Hill Vineyards** has been producing fine wines since 2001. They have earned over 80 medals and awards for quality. Visitors can savor samples in the tasting room, which is located in a historic 1923 farmhouse, and learn about **Hickory Hill's** wine making and bottling process. Visitors should call ahead to confirm hours of operation.

The final stop of the day is **Seven Doors Winery**. The beautiful grounds, wooded walking trails and an elegantly decorated 2,000 square foot tasting room provide a relaxing atmosphere for enjoying organic and biodynamic wines. Visitors should call ahead to confirm hours of operation.



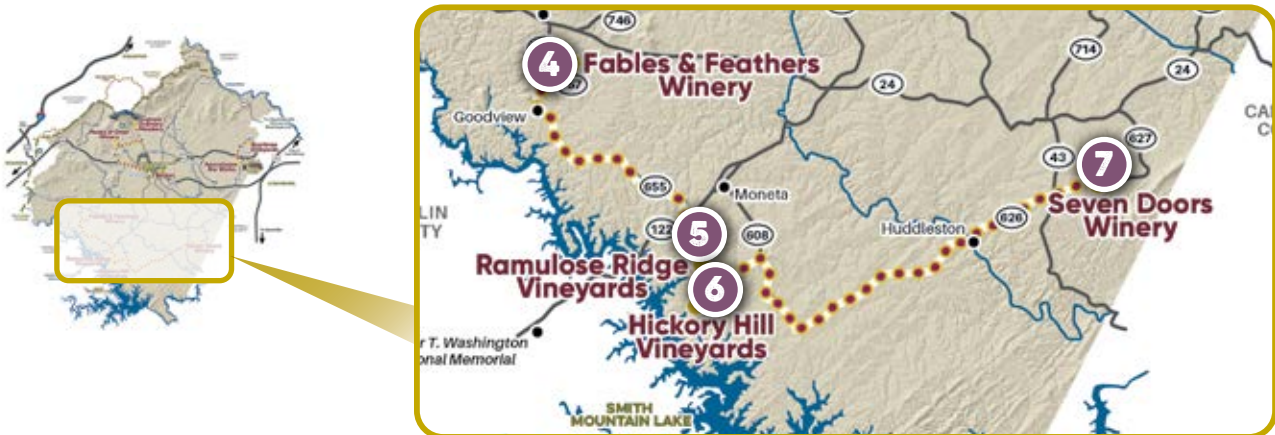

In the community of *Forest*, **Apocalypse Ale Works** ensures that the end of bad beer is here. It's the first brewery in *Forest* since Thomas Jefferson brewed at his summer home at *Poplar Forest*. Guests can also sample locally made wine and cider. The whole family will enjoy hanging out on the back deck or in the spacious courtyard filled with games like disc golf baskets.

On the eastern edge of *Forest*, **Burnbrae Vineyards** provides a peaceful setting to sample their variety of wines. Brothers Edward and Paul Gerhart created **Burnbrae Vineyards** to turn their family farm into a place for others to enjoy and share in their passion for locally-made agricultural products. The tasting room is located in a rustic log cabin, updated to include a few modern amenities, while retaining the historic charm. Open weekends, reservations are recommended.
